Please remove your garbage and recycling containers from the tree lawn after they have been emptied.....

Many of you know you should wait until 6:00 pm on Monday evenings to put your garbage and recycling totes curbside for Tuesday morning pick up. But did you know that you need to have them removed from the tree lawn area after they have been emptied? And if you do not remove them, you, as resident or owner, may be cited for violating the ordinance?

Codified Ordinance 955.10 and 955.11 says that refuse containers must be moved off any street, curb side, or public right of way, which includes the tree lawn area, no later than 6:00 pm on the day of collection. If containers are not moved, the Ada Police Department may cite you for violating the ordinance. If your containers are not removed within 24 hours of the Police Department notifying you, the Village will have the containers moved. You will then be billed for the container removal, a charge that starts at \$20, and can vary from that amount, depending on any excess labor costs, removal costs, and/or equipment costs. These charges will be placed on your water bill.

How can you avoid all this hassle and extra fees? Move your garbage and recycling containers off the street, curb side and tree lawns the same day they have been emptied.
