West Lincoln Avenue Project Underway in March

In an ideal world, progress happens overnight and none of us are inconvenienced while improvements are made. Progress in Ada may not happen overnight, but we do like warn residents when it's coming, in an effort to minimize the level of inconvenience.

With that in mind, please be aware that beginning in March, construction on Lincoln Avenue will start. The project will include West Lincoln Avenue, from Main Street continuing west past Union Street. Traffic will be limited on this stretch of West Lincoln Avenue throughout the spring and summer months. The project is expected to finish in September 2012.

The Village has been working with the businesses, churches and residents along West Lincoln Avenue, through a series of public hearings. Perhaps the greatest impact the road closure will have on residents will be for those who use the US Post Office drive through drop box located on the north side of West Lincoln Avenue. According to the US Post Office, the drive through drop box may be unavailable to customers during the construction project, since vehicle traffic will not be able to use West Lincoln Avenue during the project. Customers may need to plan accordingly so they can use the US Post Office drop box located within the Post Office building.

We appreciate your patience as we begin an improvement project that Council has determined to be in the best interest of Ada. We will continue to provide updates regarding road closures as they become available.
