Street Lighting Assessment Update –What To Do With Your Tax Bill

Last week's *Voice* brought to your attention an error in the street lighting assessment on your property tax bills. We have another update for you this week.

According to the Hardin County Auditor's Office, the Hardin County Treasurer will not be sending out new bills with the corrected millage amount. The Auditor's Office has already been very busy correcting the assessment amount in their system. As of Tuesday of this week, the Auditor's Office is handling the taxes in the following ways:

If you have already paid your bill:

- If you paid your first half taxes as billed, the overpayment will be applied as a credit on your bill for the second half of the year.
- If you paid your taxes in full for the year as billed, the credit amount may be placed in a prepay account for your taxes next year, or a check may be issued to you.

The Auditor's Office had not yet determined which option will be applied to the majority of the accounts. Some taxpayers have already requested a refund check be issued to them, and the Auditor's Office is complying with those requests.

If you have not yet paid your bill, you have two options:

- You can call the Auditor's Office at 419-674-2239 and they will be happy to give you the corrected amount of your bill; or
- You may pay your bill as received, and the overpayment will be placed on the second half as a credit.

The Village thanks you for your patience and understanding as we work to correct this issue. We are grateful to both the Hardin County Auditor's Office and Treasurer for working with us to get this issue corrected in a timely manner.
