It's Lincoln Highway Buy-way Time Once Again!

The seventh annual Lincoln Highway Buy-Way Yard Sale kicks off August 4, 5 and 6 this year. Ada continues to be a part of this multi-state sale event, and the list of sales in the Ada area continues to grow each day.

Residents may contact the Water Office to have the address of their sales added to the list, free of charge. The addresses will then be compiled into one map by Ada's Lincoln Highway Buy-Way committee. Maps for the local sales will be available closer to the sale dates. Registered participants will receive signs that can be displayed, so shoppers know that the sale is part of the great Buy-Way.

This year, shoppers and participants may also discover more about the Ohio state-wide sales online, at www.historicbyway.com. This site is sponsored by the Ohio Lincoln Highway Historic Byway board of directors. Sellers may list their sales on this website, for a fee of \$5 via PayPal.

The Village has also added a press release from the board of directors, which includes a link to the Historic Byway website, to the Village website, www.adaohio.org.

Executive director for the Ohio portion of the buy-way sale Mike Hocker emphasizes the economic aspect of the sale, including possible increased sales for merchants in the areas surrounding the sales. He points out that shoppers often stop for a bite to eat, a tank of gas, and overnight accommodations along the routes, which could benefit local economies.

The local committee for the Lincoln Highway Buy-way is headed by chair Norm Rex, and is a subcommittee of the Ada Community Improvement Corporation (CIC).
